### **Summary of Monthly Operations – September 2012**

#### General

In total, the 95 Express Lanes:

- ✓ Serviced 1,663,788 vehicle trips in September 2012 (15.7 million trips in 2012 to date), bringing the total since opening (December 5, 2008) to approximately 60.8 million trips.
- ✓ Had estimated monthly toll revenue of \$1.20 million in September 2012 (\$12.7 million in 2012) to date), bringing the total revenue to date to approximately \$47.2 million.
- ✓ Increased to a total of 8,904 registered vehicles, resulting in 32,924 toll exempt trips.










### Registrations—Toll Exempt Trips

The entire 95 Express lanes (both directions) were open to motorists 94.4% of the time, while closed 3.3% due to 10 planned construction/maintenance events (each lasting 4 hours, 45 minutes in duration on average) and 2.3% due to 140 non-recurring events (each lasting just over 14 minutes in duration on average).
