## Registrations-Toll Exempt Trips

The total exempt vehicle registrations decreased to 9,081 through November 2016. Hybrids comprise $44 \%$ of the total registrations, while High Occupancy Vehicles (HOV) like 3+ carpools, vanpools and transit comprised the other 56\%. The Weekday Toll Exempt Trips and Peak Period Toll Exempt Trips for this month are shown by classification below for each segment. On average, 52\% of all Hybrid trips occurred during the Peak Periods for November 2016.
