95 Express Monthly Operations Report - March 2018

95 Express currently has three dynamically-priced tolling segments in each direction. Segment 1 is in Miami-Dade County from just north of SR 836 to the Golden Glades Interchange (SR 826/Florida's Turnpike). Segment 2 is also in Miami-Dade County from north of the Golden Glades Interchange to just south of Ives Dairy Road. Segment 3 extends from Ives Dairy Road in Miami-Dade County to Broward Boulevard in Broward County, with access from/to I-595 via the Stirling Road Express Lanes ingress/egress.





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



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

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

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Tolls Statistics





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Registrations—Toll Exempt Trips

The total exempt vehicle registrations decreased to 8,778 through March 2018. Hybrids comprise 46% of the total registrations, while High Occupancy Vehicles (HOV) like 3+ carpools, vanpools and transit comprised the other 54%. The Weekday Toll Exempt Trips and Peak Period Toll Exempt Trips for this month are shown by classification below for each segment. On average, 54% of all Hybrid trips occurred during the Peak Periods for March 2018.







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


