



New Express Lanes on I-95

from SR 84 to Congress Avenue

In a continued effort to enhance mobility throughout the state, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has completed portions of the northbound and southbound express lanes project along I-95 from State Road (SR) 84 in Broward County to Congress Avenue in Palm Beach County. Destinations and the corresponding express lanes toll will be posted on electronic signs in advance of the entrance, giving motorists time to choose whether they would like to use the express lanes. The newly implemented tolls in the express lanes will be collected electronically using a SunPass or any other Florida compatible transponder. Customers must have an active account with the transponder properly affixed to the windshield.

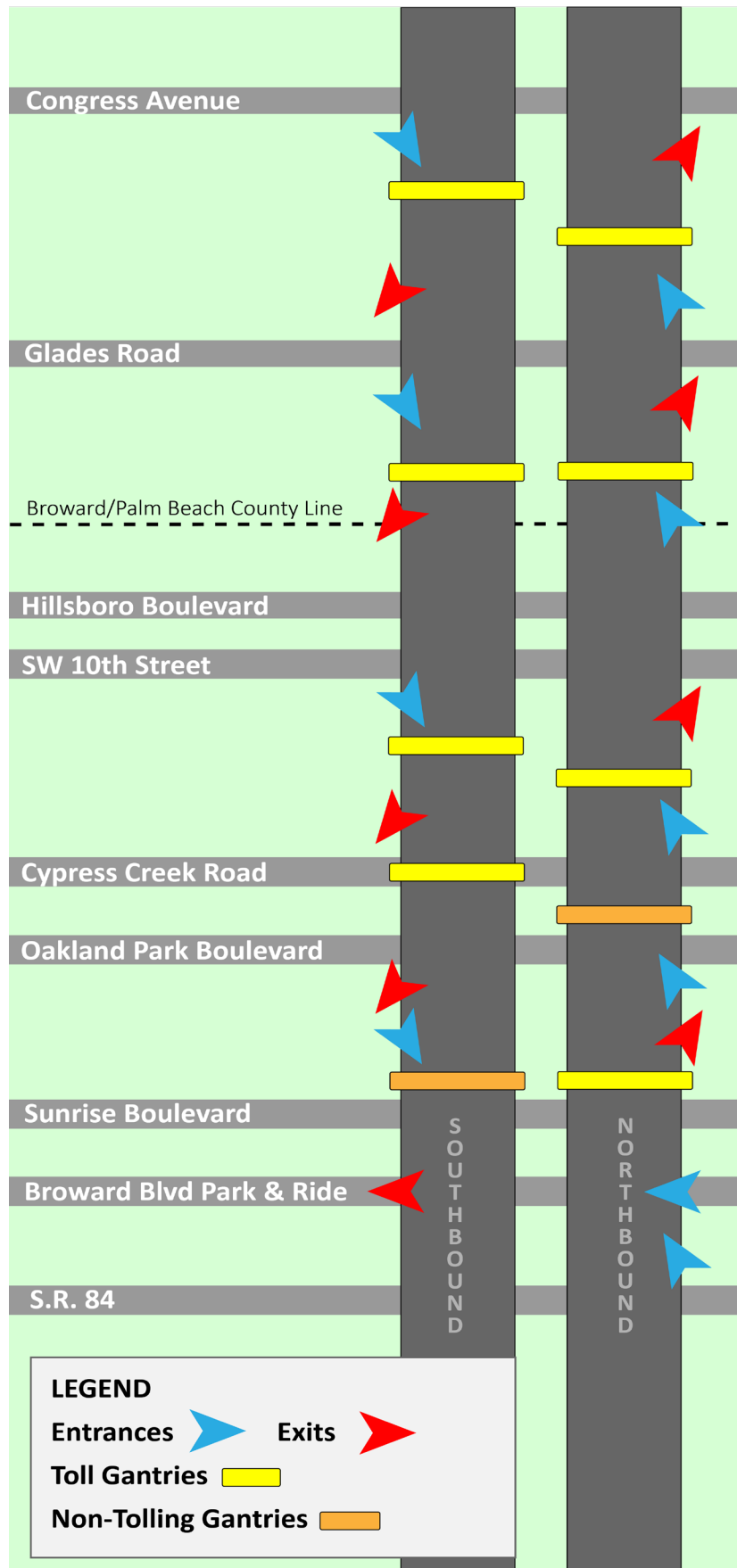

Project Overview

As part of the 95 Express Phase 3 initiative, FDOT has constructed express lanes along I-95 from State Road (SR) 84 in Broward County to Congress Avenue in Palm Beach County. One lane was added to I-95 and the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane was converted to create two express lanes in each direction. The number of general use lanes remains the same. 95 Express Phase 3 in Broward and Palm Beach counties will extend the existing Phase 1 & 2 segments currently in use in Miami-Dade County and southern Broward County to provide a safe and efficient commute for South Florida's tri-county area. Activation of the express lanes between SR 84 and Congress Avenue is anticipated to begin in November 2023. Overhead signs will advise drivers of entrance and exit locations and display the toll rates.

Project Key Components

- Express lanes dedicated entrance and exit points
- Ramp signaling to maintain consistent traffic flow and reduce crashes
- Integrated ITS (Intelligent Transportation System)/Tolling systems
- Sound barrier walls along residential neighborhoods
- Additional auxiliary lanes between interchanges



Project Benefits

This project will expand the existing express lanes system as part of the South Florida Regional Express Lanes network, which will improve safety, enhance mobility, relieve congestion and provide additional travel options along the existing I-95 corridor.

Express Lanes Use

Customers will be able to access the express lanes at designated entrance locations only. Destinations and the corresponding express lanes toll will be posted on electronic signs in advance of the entrance, giving customers time to choose whether to use the express lanes. Upon entering the express lanes, customers will pay the toll rate displayed on the sign until reaching the next decision point. Customers will never pay a higher toll amount than the rate displayed on the sign. If the toll decreases after entering the express lanes, customers will pay the lower amount until they reach the next decision point.

- South of SW 10th Street
- South of Glades Road
- South of Congress Avenue

Southbound Entrance Ramps

- South of Congress Avenue
- South of Glades Road
- South of SW 10th Street
- South of Oakland Park Boulevard

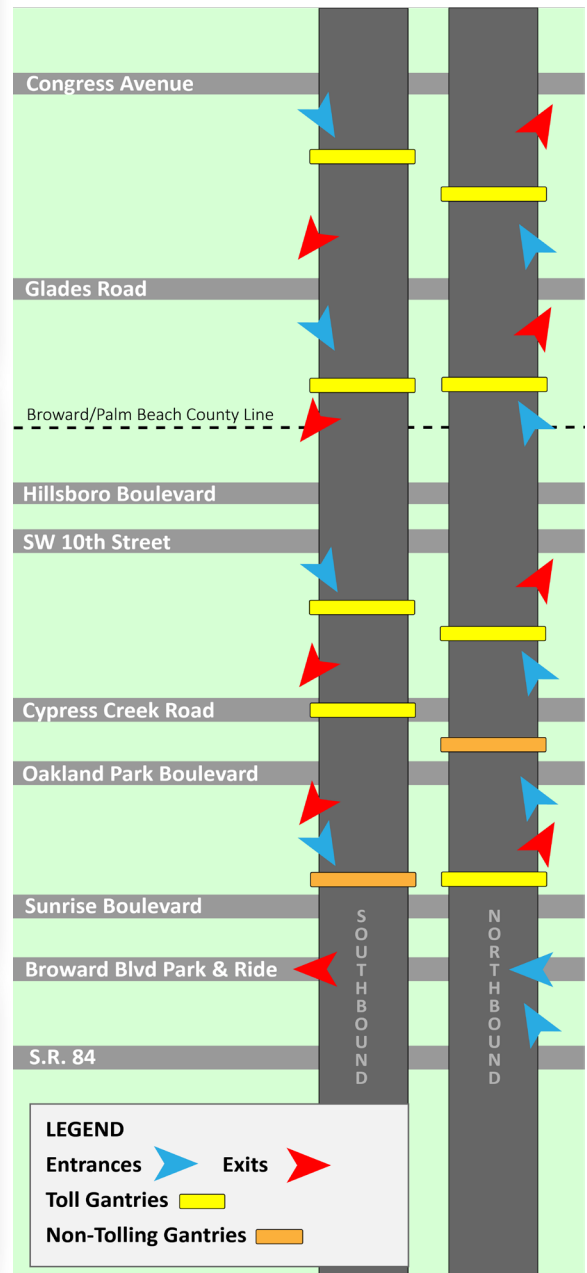
