




Registrations—Toll Exempt Trips

Facility Availability



The entire 95 Express lanes (both directions) were open to motorists 91.5% of the time, while closed 4.9% due to 17 planned construction/ maintenance events (each lasting approximately 4 hours, 27 minutes in duration, on average) and 3.6% due to 146 non-recurring events (each lasting approximately 21 minutes in duration, on average).
